MercuryGate uses standard ANSI ASC X.12 EDI version 4010 for the 214's that incorporate the ATA Motor Carrier Industry published standards. Please refer to the following information regarding implementation:

1. 214 files must have the following naming scheme:

<Message type id>-<Sender's SCAC>- <Unique ID, i.e. Timestamp>.edi.

For example:

214-ABCD-20070718120159.edi

Receiver ID (GS03):	MGCUST	(12 Char)

1. Please send 214 messages as close to real time as possible.
2. Prefer extracts be sent every 2 hours.
3. Need all status codes sent.
4. Example of minimum statuses to be sent:
 - D1 Completed Unloading at Delivery Location
 - AV Available for Delivery (final destination)
 - X4 Arrived at Terminal Location (final destination)
 - AG Estimated Delivery (final destination)
 - P1 Departed Terminal Location (from break bulk)
 - X4 Arrived at Terminal Location (at break bulk)
 - AG Estimated Delivery (at break bulk)
 - P1 Departed Terminal Location (origin terminal)
 - AF Actual Pickup (origin terminal)

Place all files being sent to MG in the “**Inbound**” directory and retrieve all 997’s from the “**Outbound**” directory.
